MINUTES
April 16, 2009

Call to Order: 6:35 by Ken Bratsch

Lori Shafer **Motioned** that Broadway donate \$1,000 toward the start of said garden, **seconded** by Barb, **approved by all.** All monies collected from the plots are to be then deposited back into the Broadway Treasury.

The Broadway Victory Garden was discussed; we are in need of workers on April 25th to help remove the sod at the garden.

Lori Shafer mentioned the possibility of having a pool party for Broadway Residents at Whitewater at Longview, Ken **motioned** that Broadway pay for a pool party for the residents if we can get a date, **seconded** by Barb, **approved by all.**

The Broadway Porch Party is Sunday, May 3rd from 1 to 4. This year's hosts are: Bob and Barb Braun, Ed and Mary Littig and Rob and Mallory Frew. Lori Shafer will make invitations for each of the Board members to hand out to new residents that may be interested in coming and she will also make signs for the Broadway insert signs.
